Exhibitor Information

Please exercise your dog in the designated areas.

Please clean up after your dog both at the show site and at your hotel.

All dogs must be kept on leash or crated at all times.

Crates may be left inside the show facility overnight in designated area; Dogs may not be left overnight.

No chalking is allowed in the building.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by email prior to the close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable. The ICDCA will not be responsible for errors made on entries.

Please double check entry prior to sending. No refund of entry fees will be made for entries cancelled after the Pre-Entry deadline or if the dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Judge, or barred from competition by the action of the Event Committee.

The ICDCA and UKC assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injuries to children.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Trial/Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class.

Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

No smoking is allowed in the building. No alcoholic beverages are allowed on the show grounds or in the parking areas.

Instructions: Fill out the dog and owner information. List all licensed, non-licensed, and junior showmanship classes entered. Ignore the Obedience, Agility, and other boxes. All dogs must have either a permanent United Kennel Club Registration Number or a Temporary Listing Number, which can only be obtained from UKC.

Be sure to sign and date the form, include Junior ID number if appropriate, include entry fees for pre-entries and mail to the **ICDCA Specialty Show Secretary, Jerry Hennings, 25074 County Road 143,**

Flemington, MO 65650 to arrive before the pre-entry deadline of **May 28, 2025**.

- * UKC and the ICDCA, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by the exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children not under the control of their parents or guardians.
 - * Absolutely no alcoholic beverages or unprescribed drugs will be allowed on or around the show grounds.
 - * The "No Smoking" rule will be strictly enforced by UKC in all buildings and areas so designated.
 - * Exhibitors and dog owners are expected and required to clean up after their own dogs. Failure to do so may cause the exhibitor to be dismissed for the day or the weekend with no refund.
 - * UKC will support complaints from local motels against exhibitors who fail to keep their dogs quiet or to clean up after them or who damage the motel property. UKC may take strong disciplinary actions against offenders.

CLASSES OFFERED

REGULAR CONFORMATION CLASSES

A dog can be entered in only 1 of the following 5 classes, must be intact (not neutered or spayed), and have not attained a Champion or Grand Champion title. For each sex there are the following classes, with males judged first and then bitches in each class:

1. Puppy - 6 months to less than 12 months the day of the show.
2. Junior - 1 year to less than 2 years the day of the show.
3. Adult - 2 years and older the day of the show.
4. Open - 6 months and older the day of the show.

5. Breeder/Handler - 6 months and older the day of the show, handled by breeder or member of the immediate family.

Best Male is then chosen from among the winners of the male classes, and Best Female is chosen from the winners of the female classes. Reserve Best Male and Reserve Best Female are also chosen. The Best Male and Best Female then compete for Best of Winners.

Champion of Champions - for dogs who've earned the Champion title.

Grand Champion - for dogs that have earned the Grand Champion title.

Best of Breed - chosen from the winners of Best of Winners, Champion of Champions, and Grand Champion competition.

ALTERED CLASSES

The altered classes and point system are the same as the classes for intact dogs and are licensed conformation classes. Purebred dogs that are permanently registered or have a valid Temporary Listing (TL) number as of the day of the show are eligible, provided that they are neutered or spayed. Dogs with Limited Privilege registration are ineligible to compete in altered licensed classes. For each sex there are the following classes, with males judged first and then bitches in each class:

1. Altered Puppy - 6 months to less than 12 months the day of the show.
2. Altered Junior - 1 year to less than 2 years the day of the show.
3. Altered Adult - 2 years and older the day of the show.
4. Altered Open - 6 months and older the day of the show.
5. Altered Breeder/Handler - 6 months and older the day of the show, handled by breeder or member of the immediate family.

The Altered Best Male is then chosen from among the winners of the male classes, and the Altered Best Female is chosen from the winners of the female classes. Altered Reserve Best Male and Altered Reserve Best Female are also chosen. The Altered Best Male and Altered Best Female then compete for Altered Best of Winners.

Altered Champion of Champions - for dogs that have earned the Altered Champion or Champion title.

Altered Grand Champion - for dogs that have earned the Altered Grand Champion or Grand Champion title.

Altered Best of Breed - chosen from the winners of Altered Best of Winners, Altered Champion of Champions, and Altered Grand Champion competition.

NON-LICENSED CLASSES (NLC)

Novice - for intact dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age that are permanently registered with UKC, or that have a valid Temporary Listing (TL) number, or that are not yet permanently registered but that are from litters registered with UKC as of the day of the show. Males will be judged first and then bitches and Best of Breed Novice Puppy will be chosen from the winners of the two classes.

Stud Dog - minimum of 2 to maximum of 4 offspring present

Brood Bitch - minimum of 2 to maximum of 4 offspring present

Brace – 2 dogs with single handler

Veteran – for dogs aged 7 years or older, may be spayed or neutered; the Best Veteran Male shall compete with the Best Veteran Female for Best Veteran of Breed.

Parade of Titleholders - must have earned at least one title from any organization

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

The age of the junior on January 1st of each year determines the division in which the junior competes for that entire year. An exception to this rule is made for a Sub-Junior that turns 8 years of age inside the Sub-Junior year; the child may move from the Sub-Junior class to the Novice Junior Class. Dogs must be 6 months or older the day of the show and females in season may not be entered or shown in Junior Showmanship. Best Junior Handler is chosen from the winners of the Jr. and Sr. classes. Pee-Wee - 2 years of age to less than 4 years of age

Sub-Junior - 4 years of age to less than 8 years of age

Junior - 8 years of age to less than 13 years of age

Senior - 13 years through 17 years of age
